PROGRAM TERMS & CONDITIONS:

QUALIFICATIONS

- The qualifying equipment must be installed in a North Dakota residence that is served or to be served with Natural Gas from Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota).
- The residence must be served under Montana-Dakota's Residential Gas Service Rate 60.
- Montana-Dakota uses ENERGY STAR® listings to determine eligibility of the equipment. You can access this information at www.energystar.gov.
- Dealers/contractors/builders are not eligible to receive their customer's rebate.
- Furnaces with a 90-94% AFUE are only eligible for the rebate if they are replacement and are not eligible for new construction or conversion.
- Equipment installed under warranty replacement does not qualify for the rebate payment.
- The natural gas heating rebate is limited to one furnace per customer.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The rebate application must be completely filled out with the purchaser information.
- Equipment information (**including a sales invoice/receipt with the brand, model number, serial number and installation date**) and dealer information.
- A copy of the AHRI (Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute) Certificate (available from the dealer).
- To receive the additional \$300 incentive for FEMA documented flood victims, include a copy of FEMA flood documentation.
- Montana-Dakota is unable to accept applications that do not include all of this information.
- It is the responsibility of the dealer and purchaser to ensure that the installed equipment qualifies for the rebate.
- Mail the completed application including a copy of the dealer invoice and/or sales receipt to:

- If the equipment does not qualify, no rebate will be paid.

INCENTIVE PAYMENT DETAILS

Rebates will be issued for equipment purchased and installed between June 1, 2010 and December 31, 2011. Funding is limited and rebates will be paid on a first come first served basis. Montana-Dakota issues rebate payments in the form of checks, not utility bill credits. Montana-Dakota is not responsible if the dealer does not provide accurate information about the amount of rebate or equipment eligibility. Please allow 4-6 weeks for incentive processing.
