PROGRAM TERMS & CONDITIONS:

QUALIFICATIONS

- The qualifying equipment must be installed in a North Dakota residence served with electricity from Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota). The residence must be served under Montana-Dakota's Residential Service Rates 10 or 16
- Montana-Dakota uses ENERGY STAR® listings to determine eligibility of the equipment. You can access this information at www.energystar.gov.
- Rebate applies to electric central air conditioning units and mini split systems that meet the efficiency requirements. The rebate does not apply to window air conditioning units or heat pump systems.
- Dealers/contractors are not eligible to receive their customer's rebate.
- Home builders are eligible for rebates and are limited to a maximum payout of \$5,000 per builder.
- Equipment installed under warranty replacement does not qualify for the rebate.
- Residential rebates (gas and/or electric) are limited to a maximum payout of \$5,000 per customer.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The rebate application must be completely filled out with the purchaser information.
- Equipment information (**including a sales invoice/receipt with the brand, model number, serial number and installation date**) and dealer information.
- A copy of the AHRI (Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute) Certificate (available from the dealer).
- To receive the additional rebate for FEMA documented flood victims, include a copy of FEMA flood documentation.
- Montana-Dakota is unable to accept applications that do not include all of this information.
- It is the responsibility of the dealer and purchaser to ensure that the installed equipment qualifies for the rebate.
- If the equipment does not qualify, no rebate will be paid.

REBATE PAYMENT DETAILS

Rebates will be issued for equipment purchased and installed between June 1, 2010 and December 31, 2011. Funding is limited and rebates will be paid on a first come first served basis. Montana-Dakota issues rebate payments in the form of checks, not utility bill credits. Montana-Dakota is not responsible if the dealer does not provide accurate information about the amount of rebate or equipment eligibility. Please allow 4-6 weeks for rebate processing.

This rebate program is funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and administered by the North Dakota Department of Commerce Office of Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency.

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
