Heating Degree Days	-	The difference between the average of the daily high and low temperatures as reported by the National Weather Service station subtracted from 60 degrees Fahrenheit.	T
Normal Degree Days	-	The heating degree days based on the 30-year average for the period 1981-2010.	
Temperature Sensitive Use per Customer	-	Customer’s actual use less the base use per customer per day, denoted below, multiplied by days in the billing period. Residential (Rate Code 600 and 601) = 0.0515 Dk per day Firm General (Rate Code 700) = 0.0725 Dk per day Firm General (Rate Code 701) = 1.4096 Dk per day	I I I
Actual Degree Days	-	The actual degree days reported by the National Weather Service Stations for applicable service areas in South Dakota.	

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
