How to calculate your bill

This information is to assist you in checking your bill. A residential service (Rate 60) is used for this example.

1. Assume use of 10.5 dk in March.

2. Basic Service Charge (31 days x \$0.30 per day)	00.00

Effective March 1, 2024

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) is implementing an interim rate increase as part of the Company's pending 2023 natural gas rate increase application. As previously noticed in your September 2023 bill, Montana-Dakota filed a natural gas rate increase request with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on August 15, 2023. If approved by the Commission as filed, the proposed new rates will result in an overall increase in revenue of \$7.4 million or 11.2 percent over current rates. The Company has made significant investments in its natural gas infrastructure to ensure safe and reliable service to customers, as well as investments in technology, causing the need for an increase in rates at this time.

On September 1, 2023 the Commission ordered the proposed rates be suspended for 180 days, pursuant to South Dakota law, as the Commission considered the Company's case. The 180 day suspension period expired on February 11, 2024.

Montana-Dakota will now implement interim rates effective with service rendered on and after March 1, 2024. If the final approved increase is lower than the interim increase implemented, Montana-Dakota will refund the difference to its customers with interest.

A typical residential customer using 66.3 dk on an annual basis will see an average increase of approximately \$7.28 per month or 13.3 percent. The interim increase will be applied as a percentage of your natural gas service bill (excluding the Cost of Gas and Conservation Tracking Adjustment) and will be shown as a separate line item on your bill. The first bill you receive may be prorated, depending on the date your meter is read. This means that only the portion of your bill for service on and after March 1, 2024 will reflect the interim rate increase.

Applicable rates for various classes of service are shown below. Gas costs are subject to change on a monthly basis.
