

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. Annual Update to the Generation Resource Recovery Rider

Effective March 1, 2019

On November 2, 2018 Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an application with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) to update its Generation Resource Recovery Rider (Generation Rider). The Generation Rider update includes North Dakota's allocation of the Company's ongoing generation investments in its Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines (RICE) units at its Lewis & Clark Generation Station that are not being recovered through the Company's electric rates.

On February 26, 2019, the Commission approved Montana-Dakota's Generation Rider rates effective with service rendered on and after March 1, 2019. A typical residential customer using 894 Kwh will see a decrease of \$0.57 per month. The Generation Rider is shown as a separate line item on your bill.

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Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. Annual Update to the Transmission Cost Adjustment

Effective March 1, 2019

On November 1, 2018 Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an application with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) to update its Transmission Cost Adjustment (TCA) rates. The TCA rate update includes North Dakota's allocation of transmission related net expenses assessed by both the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) and the Southwest Power Pool (SPP) for transmission-related services currently not being recovered through the Company's electric service rates.

On February 26, 2019, the Commission approved Montana-Dakota's rates effective with service rendered on and after March 1, 2019. A typical residential customer using 894 Kwh will see a decrease of \$0.69 per month. The is shown as a separate line item on your bill.
