## **Prorated Bill:**

The first bill you receive may be prorated, depending on the date your meter was read. Bills are prorated to reflect the rates in effect at the time service was rendered, rather than when your bill is processed. This means that any electricity used prior September 1, 2020 will be billed at the old rate and any electricity used on and after September 1, 2020 will be billed at the new rates.

# Payment:

Bills will be considered past due if not paid by the due date shown on the bill. An amount equal to 1% per month will be applied to any unpaid balance existing at the second subsequent billing date. A charge of \$30.00 will be collected by the Company for each check charged back to the Company by the financial institution.

# **New Electric Service Rates Effective September 1, 2020**

On September 28, 2018, Montana-Dakota Utilities
Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an application with the
Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) to
increase the Company's electric service rates to reflect
increased investment necessary for providing safe and
reliable service, in addition to increased operation and
maintenance expense, depreciation expense, and property
taxes. The rate increase was offset by the tax savings
associated with the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017.

On June 18, 2019, the Commission approved a Settlement Agreement between Montana-Dakota, the Montana Consumer Counsel, and Denbury Onshore LLC, authorizing a total rate increase of \$9.3 million to be accomplished in two phases. The first phase was implemented September 1, 2019 and reflected an overall rate increase of \$9 million. The second phase of the rate increase for the remaining \$300,000 is now being implemented with new electric service rates effective with service rendered on or after September 1, 2020.

A typical residential customer using 767 Kwh on a monthly basis will see an average increase of approximately \$0.42 per month.
