

Conservation Program Tracking-Rate 90

Effective Date March 1, 2021

On January 29, 2021, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an application with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to revise its Conservation Program Tracking Mechanism (CTA) pursuant to the terms of the Company's Rate 90 tariff to be effective March 1, 2021.

On February 19, 2021, the Commission approved the Company's request to update the CTA rate with the new rate effective March 1, 2021. The updated rate reflects a projection of the 2021 program expenditures as well as a true up of the 2020 actual expenses. The CTA is shown as a separate line item on your natural gas bill.

The table below provides a comparison of the residential customer's average bill at the current rate of \$0.008 per dk and the new CTA rate of \$0.020 per dk, excluding taxes.
