Plans for planting a tree, digging a hole for a mailbox, installing a fence—or any other project that requires digging?

Then, remember to call 811 at least 48 hours ahead of time to have your underground utilities marked.

The **1ST** step to any project is **safety!**

There are many utility lines buried on your property – electric, telephone, gas or propane, water, sewer, cable TV. Damaging an underground facility can cause injury or even death. Before you dig, call 811 at least 48 hours in advance of your digging project to have these lines located.

These locates do not include any lines you may have installed to your private facilities (i.e. gas grills, detached garages, wells, yard lights, etc.).

It's free. It's simple. It's the law.
