Rate 16 – Optional Time-of-Day Residential Electric Service; Rate 25 – Irrigation Power Service; Rate 26 – Optional Time-of-Day Small General Electric Service; Rate 31 – Optional Time-of-Day Large General Electric Service; Rate 32 – General Electric Space Heating Service; Rate 38 – Interruptible Large Power Demand Response; Rate 41 – Public Lighting Service; Rate 48 – Municipal Pumping Service; Rate 52 – Outdoor Lighting Service.

Universal System Benefits Charge (USBC)

The universal system benefits charge is a charge that provides funding for conservation and low-income programs.

Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment (F&PP)

The fuel and purchased power adjustment is subject to change on a monthly basis and includes the cost of fuel burned in generating plants to produce electricity and purchased capacity and energy costs.

Tax Tracking Adjustment (TTA)

The tax tracking adjustment provides for the automatic adjustment and tracking of any state and local taxes and fees paid by Montana-Dakota in the State of Montana and is applicable to the amounts billed under the Basic Service Charge, Energy Charge, and Demand Charge. The TTA is subject to change on an annual basis.

Payment:

Bills will be considered past due if not paid by the due date shown on the bill. An amount equal to 1% per month will be applied to any unpaid balance existing at the second subsequent billing date.

NSF/Returned Check Charge:

A charge of \$30.00 will be collected by the Company for each check charged back to the Company by the customer's financial institution.

Seasonal Reconnection Charges:

A charge of \$20.00 to customers with non-demand meters and \$40.00 to customers with demand meters will be collected for reconnecting electric service to a customer who request reconnection of service, at a location where the same customer discontinued the same service during the preceding twelve months.

This rate applies to all communities served for single-phase residential electric service for domestic purposes only.
