2025 will be billed at the old rate and any natural gas used on and after November 1, 2025 will be billed at the new rates

Payment:

Bills will be considered past due if not paid by the due date shown on the bill. An amount equal to 1% per month will be applied to any unpaid balance existing at the immediate subsequent billing date.

NSF Returned Check Charge:


A charge of \$30.00 will be collected by the Company for each check charged back to the Company by the customer's financial institution.

Seasonal Reconnection Charges:

A residential customer who requests the reconnection of service at the same location the customer discontinued the same service during the preceding 12-month period will be charged the Basic Service charge applicable during the period service was not being used and a \$30.00 reconnection fee during normal business hours. Standard overtime rates will be applied for reconnecting service after normal business hours.

A non-residential customer who requests the reconnection of service at the same location the customer discontinued the same service during the preceding 12-month period will be charged the Basic Service charge applicable during the period service was not being used and a \$30.00 reconnection fee during normal business hours. However, the reconnection application to seasonal businesses, such as swimming facilities and asphalt processing, may receive credit for the Distribution Delivery Charge revenue collected while in service.

On July 15, 2024, Montana-Dakota Utilities, Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) to increase its natural gas service rates. Montana-Dakota proposed an increase of \$9.4 million or an 11.1 percent overall annual increase in distribution revenues. The primary reason for the increase is increased investments in system upgrades and pipeline replacement projects to enhance the reliability, safety and integrity of the natural gas system as well as increased costs to operate and maintain that system.

On April 3, 2025, Montana-Dakota and the Montana Consumer Counsel jointly filed a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Stipulation) with the Commission for an increase in revenues of \$7.3 million or approximately 8.63 percent annually. The Commission approved the Stipulation at its October 7, 2025 agenda meeting. The new rates are effective with service rendered on or after November 1, 2025.

The actual impact to customers' bills will vary depending on the customer's rate class and the amount of natural gas used. Following is a comparison showing the bill impact by rate component for a residential customer served under Rate 60. The example assumes a monthly use of 6.5 dk billed at the rates prior to the Company's request, the interim rate implemented February 1, 2025 and the new rates effective November 1, 2025.

As previously noticed in customers' February 2025 bills, Montana-Dakota is allowed to charge customers an interim rate, if authorized by the Commission, while the Commission considers the Company's request to increase its gas rates. As the final increase approved by the Commission was less than the amount implemented under the Company's interim rates effective February 1, 2025, Montana-Dakota must refund the difference, with interest, to customers. An interim rate refund is anticipated in early 2026. More information will be provided at the time the refund is applied to customers' accounts.
