Transmission Cost Recovery Rider (TCRR)

A charge per Kwh applicable to electric service for the recovery of transmission related expenditures and investments net of revenues received from others on an annual basis. The TCRR is subject to change on an annual basis.

Infrastructure Rider (IR)

A charge per Kwh applicable to electric service for the recovery of jurisdictional costs associated with infrastructure investments in accordance with SDCL 49-34A-73 and as authorized by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission. The IR is subject to change on an annual basis.

Payment: Bills will be considered past due if not paid by the due date shown on the bill. An amount equal to 1% per month will be applied to any unpaid balance existing at the immediate subsequent billing date.

Returned Check Charge: A charge of \$40.00 will be collected by the Company for each check charged back to the Company by the customer's financial institution.

Seasonal Reconnection Charges: A charge of \$20.00 to customers with non-demand meters and \$40.00 to customers with demand meters will be collected for reconnecting electric service to a customer who requests reconnection of service, at a location where the same customer discontinued the same service during the preceding twelve months.
