

How to Figure Your Bill:

This information is to assist you in checking your bill. A residential customer taking service on Rate 10 is used for this example.

1. Assume a typical residential customer uses 500 Kwh* per month.
2. Determine amounts for each billing component of Rate 10.

Basic Service Charge (30 days x \$1.154)	\$ 34.62
Energy Charge 500 Kwh at \$0.05537	27.69
PSCA 500 Kwh at \$0.05932	<u>29.66</u>
Total Billing (excluding tax)	\$ 91.97

* A Kwh (Kilowatt-hour) is one thousand watts used for one hour. For example, the electric energy used by ten 100-watt bulbs burning for one hour equals one kwh.

The PSCA per Kwh reflected on your first bill may be prorated depending on the date your meter was read. The PSCA is prorated to reflect the PSCA in effect at the time service is actually rendered, rather than when your bill is processed. This means that any electric consumption (Kwh) used prior to May 1, 2026 will be billed at the prior rate and any electric consumption (Kwh) used on or after May 1, 2026 will be billed at the new rate.

NEW POWER SUPPLY COST ADJUSTMENT RATES Effective May 1, 2026

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (PSC) has authorized a change in Montana-Dakota's Power Supply Cost Adjustment (PSCA) Rate 50 due to an increase this past year in purchased power costs. The PSCA is subject to change annually either upward or downward depending on the specific circumstances of the period it covers including changes in purchased power costs. The cost is strictly a pass-through cost to the Company's customers and does not provide Montana-Dakota with a profit.

The net effect of the tracking adjustment is an increase in your electric rates of \$0.00913 per Kwh for primary service customers and an increase of \$0.00805 per Kwh for secondary service customers effective with service rendered on and after May 1, 2026. The PSCA is shown as a separate line item on your bill.

A residential customer using 500 Kwh during a month who had been paying \$87.95 per month will now pay \$91.97.

Residential Electric Service – Rate 10

This rate is applicable to all communities for residential electric service through one meter in a single private residence for all domestic uses, except electric space heating.

Energy Charge	\$0.05537 per Kwh
PSCA.....	\$0.05932 per Kwh

Small General Electric Service – Rate 20

This rate is applicable to all types of general electric service with billing demands of 50 Kilowatts (Kw) or less, except by special contracts or other rate schedules applicable to specific services.

Small General Service Rate 20 Secondary Service (Non Demand Metered)

Basic Service Charge.....	\$1.385 per day
Energy Charge	\$0.03003 per Kwh
PSCA.....	\$0.05932 per Kwh

Irrigation Power Service - Rate 25

This rate is applicable for all irrigation power service, except customers choosing the Irrigation Power Service– Optional Time of Day Rate 26

Basic Service Charge.....	\$2.310 per day
Demand Charge	\$9.83 per Kw
Energy Charge	\$0.03212 per Kwh
PSCA.....	\$0.05932 per Kwh

Large General Electric Service – Rate 39

This rate is applicable to all types of general electric service with billing demands exceeding 50 Kilowatts (Kw), except by special contracts or other rate schedules applicable to specific services.

Basic Service Charge.....	\$165.00 per month
Energy Charge	\$0.01398 per Kwh
Demand Charge	\$13.95 per Kw
PSCA.....	\$0.05459 per Kwh

Large General Electric Service – Rate 39 Secondary Service

Basic Service Charge.....	\$82.50 per month
Energy Charge	\$0.00589 per Kwh
Demand Charge	\$14.50 per Kw
PSCA.....	\$0.05932 per Kwh
