How to figure your bill:

This information is to assist you in calculating your bill.

A residential rate is used for this example.

1. Assume a month's use of 1,000 Kwh*
2. Basic Service Charge (\$0.247 x 30) \$ 7.41
3. Energy Charge:
750 Kwh @ \$0.07923 \$59.42
250 Kwh @ \$0.04923 \$12.31
4. Infrastructure Rider
(1,000 Kwh @ \$0.00497) \$ 4.97
5. Transmission Cost Recovery Rider
(1,000 Kwh @ \$0.00438) \$ 4.38
6. Fuel and Purchased Power
(1,000 Kwh @ \$0.02426) \$24.26
- Total Bill (not including tax) \$112.75**

* A Kwh (Kilowatt-hour) is one thousand watts used for one hour. For example, the electric energy used by ten 100-watt bulbs burning for one hour equals one Kwh.



TIME FOR ANNUAL ELECTRIC ENERGY RATE REVIEW IN SOUTH DAKOTA

The purpose of this brochure is to provide you with information regarding your electric energy rates. The Company's tariffs are not changing; however, this information may be helpful when reviewing your electric bill.

Review of Energy Costs for Montana-Dakota Electric Customers

Electric energy is measured in Kilowatt-hours. The abbreviation Kwh is used in the rate schedules which follow.

An adjustment mechanism referred to as the Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment is applicable to the energy you use each month. The amount of the charge may vary each month according to the cost of fuel burned in generating plants to produce electricity and purchased power costs. The FCA effective November 1, 2017 is 2.426¢ per Kwh.

Residential Electric Service—Rate 10

This rate applies to all communities served for single-phase residential electric service for domestic purposes only.
